Dungarron Talisman

Brown (also known as Seal Brown) is genetically a bay based pony that has no Dilution genes. These ponies have to carry a minimum of one copy of Black (dominant extension) as well as at least one copy of Agouti. There is another gene, yet to be identified that causes a true Brown pony but until the gene is found these ponies test exactly the same as a bay (the Pangare gene could be the cause).
