Rosemarkie Corrie

Cream Dun (also known as Grey Dun) is a bay based pony that has the Dun Dilution gene as well as the greying with age gene. These ponies have to carry a minimum of one copy of Black (dominate extension) as well as one copy Agouti, at least one copy of Dun and a copy of greying with age.
